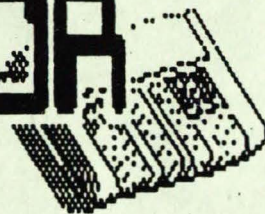

LTC SCHEDULES OPEN REGISTRATION AND ORIENTATION -Lima Technical College has scheduled "open registration" from Monday through Thursday, September 13-16, from 10:00-6:00 in the new Public Services Building. Fees are due by Friday September 17. Orientation for all new students will be September 20 and 21.

CAMPUS BOOKSTORE HOURS - The beautiful new Campus Bookstore, located in the Public Services/Administration Building, will have expanded hours during the first week of school for your convenience --- September 20 and 21, 8:00-6:00; September 22 and 23, 8:00-8:00; and September 24 8:00-5:00. The Bookstore will resume their standard hours on Monday September 27 ---Monday and Tuesday. 8:00-6:00 and Wednesday, Thursday and Friday 8:00-5:00.

SMOKING NOT PERMITTED IN BUILDINGS - The buildings on the Lima Campus are a completely smoke free environment. Smokers may smoke on the grounds of the Campus, except on the new patio area outside the newly remodeled Galvin Commons SnackBar. Hours in the SnackBar are 7:00-7:30, Monday through Thursday and 7:00-2:00 on Friday. The CAFETERIA has also had a facelift! They'll be serving hot breakfast items, as well as cold, for your convenience from 7:00-9:30 each morning. Lunch hours have been expanded from 10:00-2:00.

PARKING AND SECURITY INFORMATION - All vehicles parked on Campus property must be registered and decals displayed on the windshield of the auto. Parking stickers are available throughout the year at the Security Office in Reed 168 or in the Financial Aid office in PS/Adm. Building. ----- The Campus Security offers several services to students. If you've locked your keys in your car or are having car problems they can help. They also offer an escort service from any of the Campus buildings to your car until 11:00 pm. Monday through Friday. Calls to Security are FREE from any Campus payphone. Just dial 499. There is now a new OUTDOOR PAY PHONE in the Courtyard area in front of the new Public Services/Administration Building. Security warns you to lock your car doors, stow valuables in locked trunk or out of sight, and report any suspicious activity in the parking lots or elsewhere to the Security Office.
