The Staff for the 1917 Session of the Lake Laboratory at Cedar Point has been announced as follows: Prof. F. H. Kreckler, Ohio State University, Acting Director; Prof. S. R. Williams, Miami University; Prof. Paul S. Welch, Kansas State Agricultural College; Prof. M. E. Stickney, Denison University; Prof. Chas. H. Otis, Western Reserve University.
