

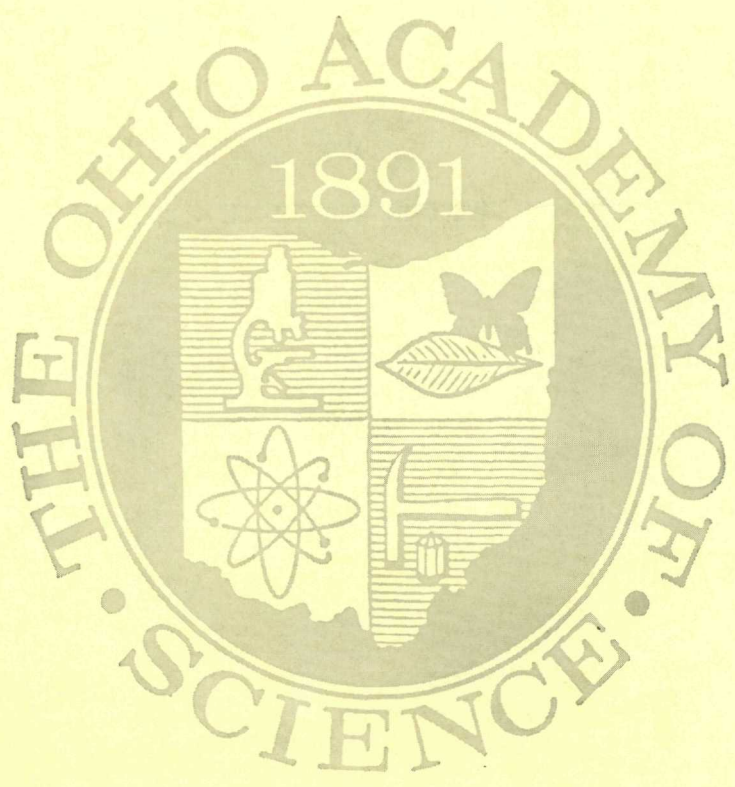

All manuscripts will be critically reviewed and are subject to the approval of the Editorial Committee. It should be understood that the opinions expressed by the reviewers are their own, and do not represent the views of the OHIO ACADEMY OF SCIENCE or OHIO JOURNAL OF SCIENCE. Manuscripts and illustrations should be prepared in triplicate and submitted to the Editor, OHIO JOURNAL OF SCIENCE, Department of Physiology, Ohio State University, 1645 Neil Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43210.

**PAGE CHARGES:** Publication of papers in the OHIO JOURNAL OF SCIENCE requires consideration of publication costs. There is no charge for the first 4 pages published in any one year and \$35 per page charge for manuscripts in excess of 4 printed pages or having excess tables or illustrations.

Page charges apply uniformly to both members and non-members, and are not a condition for acceptance or rejection of any manuscript. If the author or authors cannot pay the page charges, it will be necessary to petition the OHIO ACADEMY OF SCIENCE for possible waiver of page charges.

**SUBSCRIPTIONS:** Annual dues of active members of the OHIO ACADEMY OF SCIENCE include a subscription to the OHIO JOURNAL OF SCIENCE. Regular annual subscription to the OHIO JOURNAL OF SCIENCE is \$15 (outside the continental United States—\$16.50). Single issues for Academy members are \$3 each, for non-members, \$3.50. Discounts are available for bulk subscriptions. The OHIO JOURNAL OF SCIENCE is issued bimonthly, January to November, with 6 issues per volume.
