New Dean
Appointed

The appointment of Dr. Francis E. Hazard as Dean and Director of the Ohio State University Marion Campus was announced Wednesday, November 7, by John T. Mout, Vice President for Regional Campuses of The Ohio State University. The appointment is subject to approval by the Board of Trustees at its meeting on Friday, November 30, 1979. Hazard's appointment will become effective on February 1, 1979.

The current Dean and Director, C. Eugene Maynard, earlier announced his plans to retire after serving for 22 years as the chief administrative officer of The Ohio State University on the Marion Campus.

"We are indeed fortunate to attract Dr. Hazard to The Ohio State University Marion Campus," said Vice President Mout. "His appointment has the enthusiastic endorsement of those who represent the Marion Campus faculty, staff, students, and the Marion Campus Citizens Council. He will bring to this important position the best kind of personal qualities and leadership."
