Special consideration will be given to short papers (no more than six double-spaced type-written pages) and Ohioiana. All papers will be critically reviewed and are subject to the approval of the Editorial Committee. It should be understood that the opinions expressed by the reviewers are their own and do not represent the views of the *Ohio Journal of Science* or of the Ohio Academy of Science.

An original and one copy of each manuscript must be submitted to the Editor. An additional copy of the paper should be retained by the author for reference. The title page should indicate the mailing address of the individual to whom correspondence should be addressed. Galley proof, engraver's proof and the original manuscript will be returned to the author for final approval of the materials as set. See past numbers of the *Journal* and the *Style Manual for Biological Journals* for detailed instructions on the preparation of manuscripts.
