**Great Lakes Basin: Symposium.** Edited by *Howard J. Pincus*. Pub. 71 of Am. Assn. Adv. Sci. 1962. 320 p. \$7.50 (\$6.50 to AAAS Members).

Fifteen of the eighteen papers presented at Chicago, Dec., 1959, plus one new one, have been assembled in an excellent reference volume. The papers have been grouped according to natural relationships under three headings, The Natural Setting, Man's Adaptation on the Basin, and Utilization of Water. An Epilogue points out deficiencies in facts at hand and poses problems for future workers if the Great Lakes are to be used best for citizens of Canada and the United States.
