
The Geology along Route 40 in Ohio. *Pauline Smyth.* Information Circular No. 16, Ohio Division of Geological Survey, Columbus. 1955. vi+65 pp. \$.25.

This interesting booklet is one of a series by the Geological Survey, designed to acquaint the average person with the geology of Ohio.

The author divides the National Road into 25 sections, from the Ohio River to the Indiana boundary. Each is represented by a map of a scale of $\frac{1}{2}$ inch to the mile, on which is shown the geological, and many of the cultural, features of the area, together with a page of explanatory text. There are other helpful charts and maps and numerous excellent photographs.

The booklet will appeal not only to the beginner but also to the advanced amateur and even the professional geologist whose specialty happens to lie in other areas. Every traveler over U. S. 40 would do well to have a copy.
