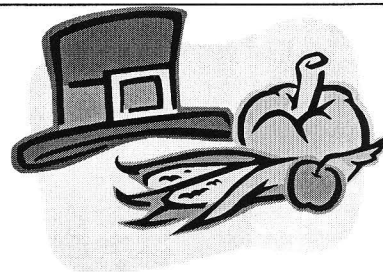

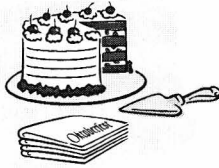

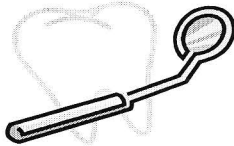

DENTAL HYGIENE

The Rhodes State College Dental Hygiene Clinic welcomes students, faculty and staff of the Lima Campus to make an appointment by calling (419) 995-8346 or by stopping by the clinic in Cook Hall (next to the library). Services provided include teeth cleaning, bite-wing x-rays, fluoride treatment, oral health instructions, oral cancer screening, diabetic screening, nutritional counseling and tooth desensitization. Cleanings are "free" for students, faculty and staff, however, a nominal fee is charged for dental sealants, panorex and cmx x-rays. Dental hygiene students are supervised by licensed dental professionals.

Association of Childhood Education

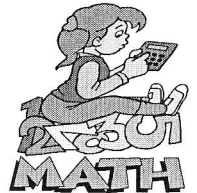

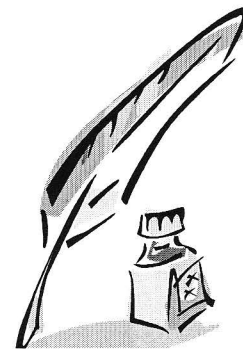
