

ELECTED OAS PATRON

Mrs. Ethel Melsheimer Miller of Sarasota, Florida was elected a patron of the Ohio Academy of Science at its April 24th meeting at Denison University. Mrs. Miller is the fourth Patron elected by the Ohio Academy of Science since its founding in 1891.

Born in 1885 in Van Wert, Ohio, Mrs. Miller graduated from Wittenberg University in 1907. From 1908 to 1917 she taught Latin and literature in several Ohio public schools. In 1917 she joined the staff of The Ohio State University Libraries and later she became librarian for the Ohio Academy of Science. She retired in 1947 and since that time has been a "good will ambassador" for the Ohio Journal of Science.

It was through her efforts that the circulation of the Ohio Journal of Science was extended to dozens of foreign libraries, many of which she personally visited after her retirement. She was elected a Patron of the Ohio Academy of Science at the Denison meeting for her unusually distinguished service to science in Ohio.
