In the list of papers relating to Canadian dragonflies I omitted Mr. Van Duzee's paper, *List of Dragonflies Taken Near Buffalo, N. Y., Journ., N. Y., Ent. Soc., Vol. V, June, 1897, pp. 87-91*, in which he records the capture of *Anomalagrion hastatum* Say at Point Abino, Ontario. I failed to list this with the other Canadian species.
