CORRECTED DESCRIPTION OF PHYLLOSTICTA ALCIDES.

Through some unaccountable mistake the description of this species was not given correctly on p. 223 of the preceding No. of the OHIO NATURALIST. It should have been as follows :

PHYLLOSTICTA ALCIDES Ell. & Kellerm.—Spots cinereous, epihyllous, subindefinite, 2-4 mm. Perithecia scattered on the spots, punctiform, 100-120  $\mu$  diam., raising and puncturing the epidermis, soon perforated above. Sporules short-fusoid or oblong, yellowish, 2-3-nucleate, 7-15 (mostly 7-10)  $\times$  3-3½  $\mu$ . Found associated with *Leptosphaeria alcides* Sacc., of which it is apparently the spermogonial stage.
