
Elements of Zoology. *Tracy I. Storer and Robert L. Usinger.* McGraw-Hill Book Co., Inc., New York. xii+552 pp. \$5.50.

Elements of Zoology is an abridgement of Storer's highly successful and well-known General Zoology. The reduction of one-third has been accomplished primarily in Part II which treats the animal kingdom. Part I on animal biology remains essentially the same size but the material is rearranged and rewritten. Elements of Zoology is designed for a one semester course. The content favors substantial instruction in classical zoology. We predict this text, like its parent, will find wide use.
