### A Walk in Our 'Shoe: The History of Ohio Stadium

While thousands of fans stream to Ohio Stadium on September 7, an exhibit describing the history of the Horseshoe will be unveiled at The Ohio State University's Thompson (Main) Library. From September 7 through December 13, the University Archives will sponsor: *A Walk in Our 'Shoe: The History of Ohio Stadium*. The exhibit is free and open to the public during the hours the Thompson (Main) Library is open.

Ohio Stadium is the focal point of every football Saturday in Columbus. Over its 80 year history, the Stadium has been the stage for perfect seasons, players who have ruled the field, breathtaking wins, and difficult defeats. In rain, heat, and snow, the Buckeye fans come to the Stadium to see the game and the pageantry surrounding it. Although football will always be the main reason for the structure, the experiences in the Stadium have included much more, as was intended by its designers. Throughout its years, the walls of the 'Shoe have also seen students living within them, theatrical plays shown beneath them, and parents beaming as their child receives a degree. Jesse Owens set records on its track, and famous performers set up their stage on its field. The traditions and stories surrounding Ohio Stadium are as diverse as those who have been there. This exhibit explains the history of the Horseshoe and the events that took place inside.

Artifact highlights of the exhibit include:

- A complete football uniform from 1938
- Goal post piece from 1955
- Jersey from 2002, courtesy of the OSU Athletic Department
- Woody Hayes' marching band beret
- Dedication day (1922) newspaper
- Manager book and football from 1934
- Heisman Trophy winner coins
- Jesse Owens' broad jump gold medal from the 1935 Amateur Athletic Union meet

The Ohio State University Thompson (Main) Library is located at the south end of the Oval at 1858 Neil Avenue. Parking is available at the Ohio Union parking ramp. Handicapped parking is located on South Oval Mall, adjacent to the library.

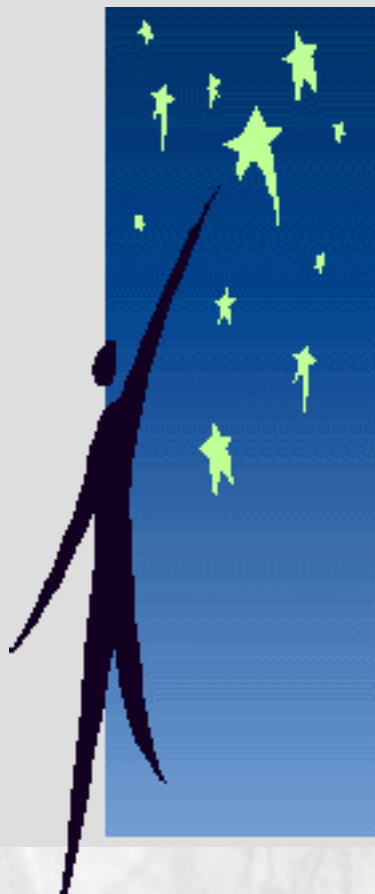

## Training Opportunities & Tips

*Presented by the OSUL Training Advisory Council*

**Web-based OSCAR/Circulation Training** -- Over the past year a Subcommittee of the Training Advisory Council has been preparing Web-based training for OSCAR/Circulation. A decision was made to rely on the instructions provided for searching OSCAR in net.TUTOR, but modules covering character-based circulation, as well as an introduction to OSCAR files, records, and displays were the first to be developed and have been available for some time. An additional module dealing with updating records via both circulation and catalog maintenance modes was added in June and included full descriptions of every record type and every field within each record type. The newest addition became available in mid-July and covers basic circulation procedures using Millennium. All of the training modules being produced include complete instructions with plenty of illustrations, brief lesson reviews, and self quizzes.
