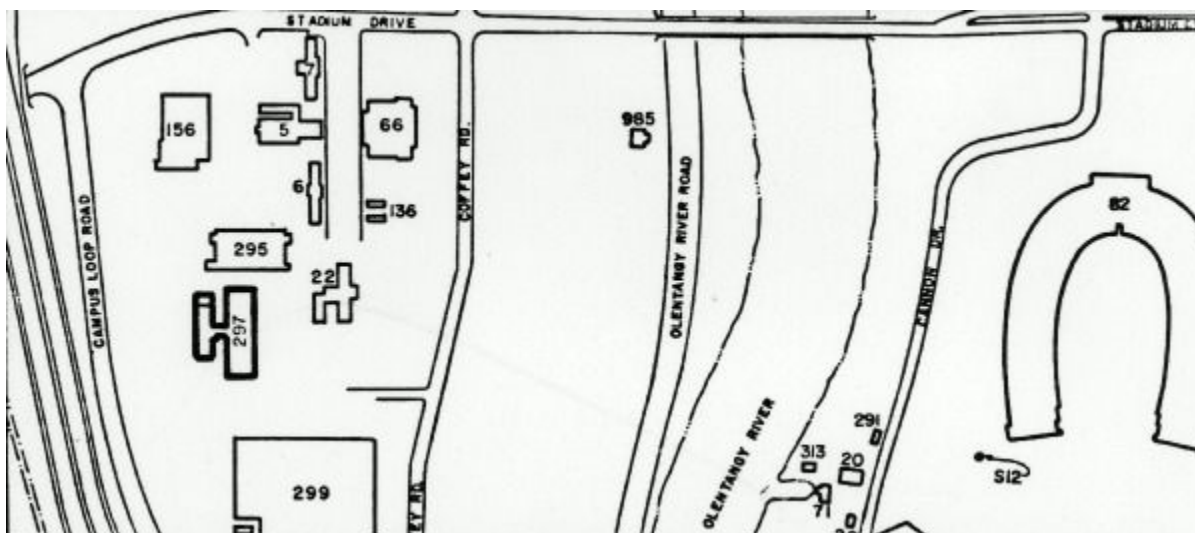
Built as part of "Horticulture, Forestry and Food Technology Center" (Bldg. 295).

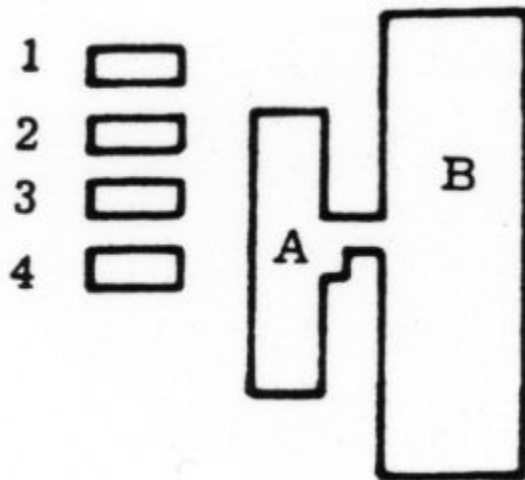

3. General Description

3.1 Type of construction:

Building A is a brick headhouse; Building B a glass greenhouse on a steel frame; and Buildings 1-4 are plexiglass or similar translucent plastic on steel frames. See sketch.



3.2 Increments of construction

No additions.

3.3 Present area of building as shown in Inventory records of Division of Campus Planning:

43,008 square feet gross,
25,872 square feet net assignable

These areas include Buildings A and B. Buildings 1-4 are approximately 24' x 48' each. In addition, there are at the time of writing (June 1972), two lath houses south and slightly west of Building 4.

Note: The design of Building B is such that it has three gables on each end and may look like three attached greenhouses. Since there are no interior partitions, this is considered as one greenhouse.

B. PLANNING & CONSTRUCTION

1. This building was planned and built as part of the "Horticulture, Forestry and Food Technology Center." See Building 295 for details.
2. The greenhouse portion of the project was accepted from the contractor on March 18, 1970 (A).
3. Buildings 1-4 were constructed as extras to the Lord and Burnham contract
