An Update on Library Binding:

The transition of binding contractors from General Bookbinding Company to the Heckman Bindery, Inc. is progressing and nearing completion. On July 13, the first shipment of books and serials to be bound at the Heckman Bindery was picked up by the Heckman delivery vehicle for return to us July 27. (Our last shipment from General Bookbinding was delivered July 6 and is being distributed to all public service locations at this time.)

This first shipment to Heckman was uncharacteristically small, at only 215 volumes, due to a combination of computing/database problems and short lead time to prepare the shipment. Nevertheless, this small shipment will serve as a test at Heckman of our specific binding requirements.

Bindery Preparation is now in full production to work off any existing books and journals in queue from public service locations. We very much appreciate your understanding of the month of July as a binding moratorium" month, to allow us to go through this transition period between the two binders, while avoiding unnecessary delays your materials in Bindery Preparation.

Beginning August 1, binding quotas will resume as before.

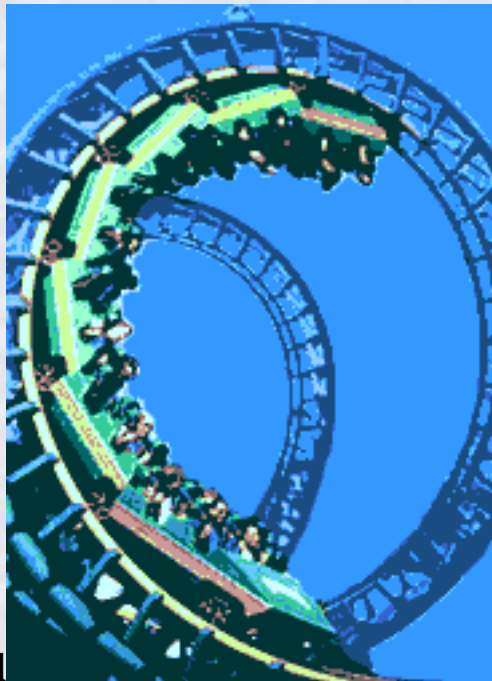
